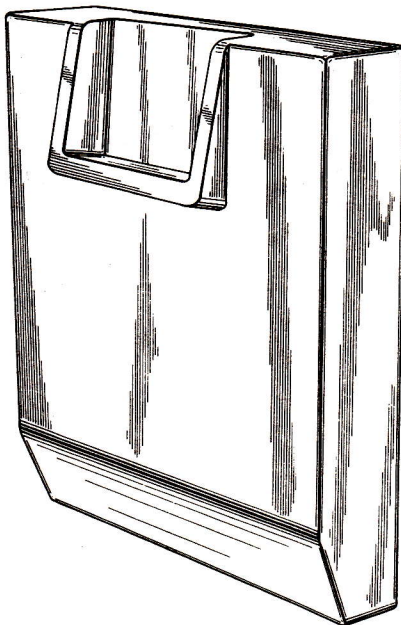

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a housing for a wall-mount telephone set base, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The attached FIGURE is a right side, top and front view of a housing for a wall-mount telephone set base showing our new design. The undisclosed left side, bottom end, and rear surfaces are flat and unadorned. The undisclosed left side is similar to the view of the right side shown.
