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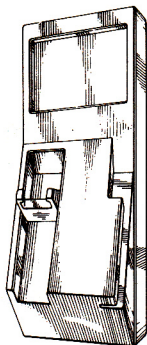

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a housing for credit card payment telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side perspective view of a housing for a credit card payment telephone showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIGS. 3 and 4 are respectively right and left side elevational views thereof;
FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively bottom and top plan views thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



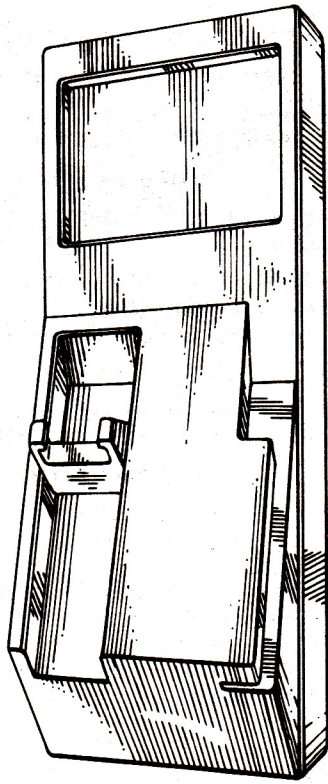

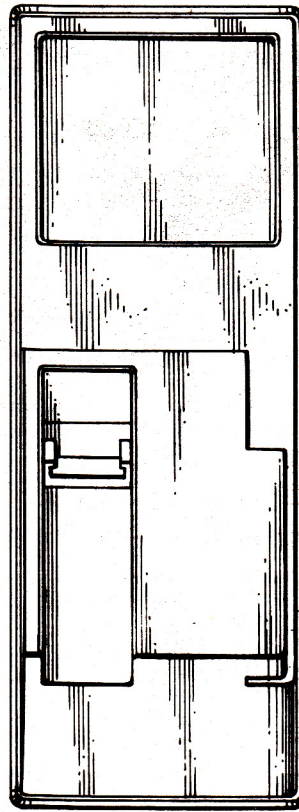

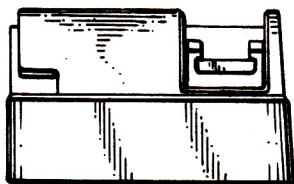

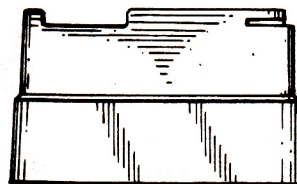

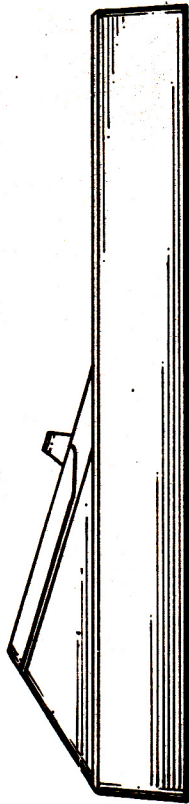

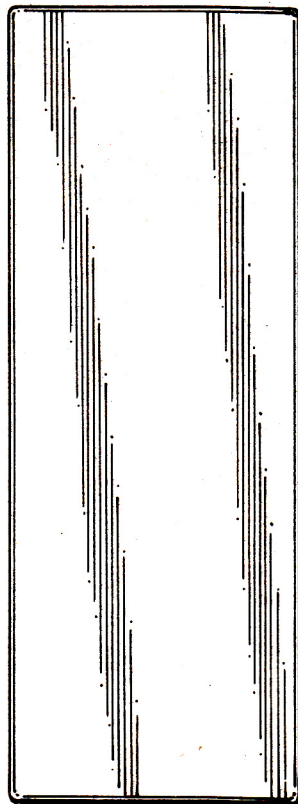

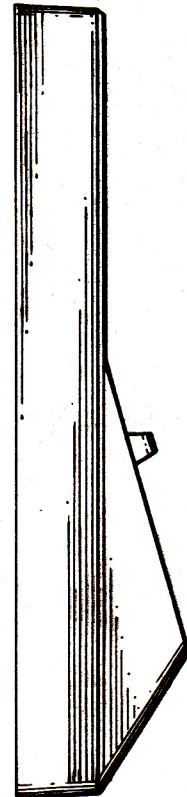
